

PATROL and TROOP GEAR

- There is a simple process for gear that goes home after a trip and for its return. An equipment logbook is in the trailer, so easy record it out, and record it in.
 - Gear is assigned and recorded to a scout to take home to clean and inventory by Troop Leadership or Quartermaster
 - All gear will be inspected, and recorded as returned at the next scheduled troop meeting after a trip by a Quartermaster. Cook Sets and Dry Goods boxes must be complete
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- **Tents and tarps need to be set out at home and COMPLETELY DRY before being returned, logged in and stored**
- **Kitchen sets, boxes and coolers need to be cleaned and COMPLETELY DRY prior to being returned, logged in and stored**

Dry Goods Box

- Salt/pepper
- Spray cooking oil
- Paper towels
- Drying towel

- Sponge/scrub pad
- Scrub brush
- Lighter stick

Some other provided in trailer

- 3 wash basins for each patrol
- Liquid dish detergent
- Bleach
- Trash bags
- Hand sanitizer
